The sailing tradition at **Seattle Yacht Club**, continues with our 2007 Adult Sailing Classes, **all classes are open to the public; membership is not required.** SYC will be offering three adult sailing sessions throughout the Summer on **Monday and Wednesday evenings from 5:30 pm until 7:30pm.** The classes will start with the basics including rigging, points of sail, sail trim, boat-handling, and boating safety. Students will develop their skills through on-the-water sessions, "chalk talk" discussions, and work in textbooks. The classes will include on the water drills to develop techniques.

The **420** is the ideal entry level training boat for all ages. This stable, double-handed boat with jib and main sail is the national standard for training, as well as collegiate competition. It is a perfect boat for novice sailors to develop their skills, and teamwork. The advance sailor can add the boat's spinnaker and trapeze to raise the sailing challenge. Our more advanced students will be able to sail Seattle Yacht Club's **Laser** and **Byte** class sailboats. Both are high-performance single-handed boats well-suited to continue the development of our more experienced sailor's boat handling and racing skills. The Laser, an Olympic Class boat, is appropriate for sailors over 150 pounds, while the Byte provides similar performance in a platform better suited to our lighter students.

Students should anticipate getting wet, and bring appropriate clothing, as we will begin sailing the first evening.

The only prerequisites are basic swimming skills, and a desire to learn to sail and have fun.
