CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

LIL' LUFFERS

Ages: 7-9 Boats: Vanguard 15 (V-15) and 420

Lil' Luffers is the perfect choice for our youngest sailors. Students sail in Vanguard 15 or 420 sailboats with one or two peers and an instructor. The low student-to-instructor ratio places an emphasis on safety and learning! This course is designed to be a fun and un-intimidating introduction to sailing and water safety.

Prerequisite: Must be 7 years old, and be able to pass a basic swimming test.

OVERBOARD OPTIS

Ages: 8-12 Boats: Optimist

The Opti sailor will learn a wide variety of skills, from sailing fundamentals to beginning racing. At the beginning of the session, the class may be broken up into groups based on skill level. In some segments of the class, all skill levels will sail together so they can have fun and learn from their own peer group.

JUNIOR JIBERS

Ages: 10-13 Boats: Vanguard 15, Laser, and 420

The Junior Jibers class is suitable for all levels of experience. Students will have the opportunity to sail with a friend in a two-person V-15 or 420, or sail individually in a Laser. A wide variety of skills will be covered, from sailing fundamentals to beginning racing. **Weight recommendation:** Minimum 100 lbs.

HIGH SCHOOL

Ages: 14-18 Boats: Vanguard 15, Laser, and 420

The High School class is suitable for all levels of experience. Students will have the opportunity to sail with a friend in a two-person V-15 or 420, or sail individually in a Laser. A wide variety of skills will be covered, from sailing fundamentals to beginning racing.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

LEARN-TO-RACE CAMP

Optimist: Ages 9-13 *Vanguard 15: Ages 10-18
***Laser: Ages 13-18**

This one-week session will run from **JULY 10 - 14**. This course is intended to be an un-intimidating introduction to racing sailboats. Students will learn boat-handling techniques, starting, rules, tactics, and more, with a fun regatta on the last day of the class.

Prerequisite: Students must have had at least one class of Sailing School at SYC, and/or be comfortable demonstrating basic sailing maneuvers, such as steering, tacking/jibing, and docking.

***Weight recommendation:** Minimum 100 lbs.

BOAT DESCRIPTIONS



The *Optimist* (Opti) is a kid-sized individual dinghy that is easy to manage and fun to sail.



Students will sail with a friend in the double-handed *Vanguard 15* (V-15).



The *Laser* is a fun, single-handed training boat.



Advanced sailors can learn to rig the spinnaker in the double-handed *420*.

Participation Requirements:

Every sailor will be required to:

- Pass a relatively easy swim test on the first day of each session.
- Wear a properly fitting U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket at all times on the water and dock.
Life jacket rentals are available for \$10 per week.
- Wear shoes at all times. Sailing shoes, Aqua Socks or Teva-type sandals are OK. Flip-flop sandals are not recommended.



Kick-Off Barbeque:

Monday, June 26th
5:30 - 7:00 p.m.

See the boats the students will be sailing and meet the instructors! Burgers, hot dogs, and salad will be served on the lawn at SYC. The summer sailing staff will be on hand to introduce themselves and answer questions about the SYC sailing programs.

Cost is \$15 per person.



Instructors:

The Seattle Yacht Club employs 12-15 summer sailing instructors each week. The instructors are all experienced sailors, with Level 1 Instructor Certification from U.S. Sailing, and First Aid and CPR training through the American Heart Association.



Every Student will Receive:

- * **Pictures** of the sailors in action.
- * A **Certificate** to recognize course completion.
- * The annual Summer Sailing School **T-shirt**.
- * The **Little Red Book**. The Little Red Book is U.S. Sailing's certification system. As the sailors progress, instructors will sign off on the skills mastered.

U.S. Sailing's curriculum will be used and taught from the textbook *Learn Sailing Right*.

Release of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement:

I am the parent or legal guardian of _____, a minor ("Child"). To induce the Seattle Yacht Club, its employees, agents, insurers, members, trustees and officers (hereinafter collectively and individually referred to as "SYC") to permit Child to enroll and participate in SYC's junior sailing programs and related SYC activities, I hereby release SYC and agree to hold SYC harmless from any and all claims for injuries to Child or damages suffered by Child as a result of negligence of SYC and accept full responsibility of the cost of treatment for any injury suffered by Child while participating in SYC programs, or in transit to or from SYC. I acknowledge that there is risk of injury inherent in small boat sailing and Sailing School activities and accept the risk on behalf of Child. I represent that I am authorized by every other person standing in a similar relation to Child to make this agreement on his or her behalf. The term of this agreement shall be one year, unless earlier terminated by written notice to SYC, except that it shall not expire or terminate as to occurrences while it is in effect.

Photo Release: SYC occasionally uses images in its promotional materials. SYC shall have the right, for any purpose whatsoever, to use, reproduce, copyright, distribute, and provide access to any photos taken during SYC's sailing programs, regattas, and related SYC activities.
