## Notice of Race

### **1.0 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Sailing Instructions, and by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including appendix [BB Experimental Kiteboarding Competition Rules](#)

### **2.0 ELEGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 Eligible kites may register by contacting Andy Koch at [kochsailing@gmail.com](mailto:kochsailing@gmail.com)
- 2.2 Early registration is recommended.
- 2.3 All kites will be assigned a numbered jersey for the race that must be worn while racing. A jersey fee of \$25 dollars will be required of all competitors and will be yours to keep for any future series races. Lost jerseys will be subject to a replacement fee.

### **3.0 FEES**

- 3.1 Entry fee is \$20. Jersey fee is \$25.

### **4.0 SCHEDULE**

- 4.1 This is a weather dependant event. Based on the forecasts race notices will be made 48, 24 and 5 hours prior to scheduled event days.
- 4.1 Skippers meeting will be held in [Magnusen Park](#) at 1200 on October 17th.
- 4.2 First race warning scheduled for 1300.

### **5.0 LAUNCH LOCATION AND SAILING AREA**

- 5.1 Launch area will be [Magnuson Park](#) south of the boat launch on Sand Point, Lake Washington.
- 5.2 Racing area will be on Lake Washington in the vicinity of Magnuson Park and Kirkland.

### **6.0 CLASSES AND SCORING**

- 6.1 There will be 3 classes to allow maximum participation. A. class will be for race boards. B. class will be for surfboards and non race directional. C. class will be for twin tips.
- 6.2 All classes will start and finish together. There will be overall scoring as well as divisions scoring by class.
